Initial Condition (including the "Knot"): The thing that is wrong with your character.
Inciting Event: Something that forces your character to deal with it.
Escalation: Make it progressively harder for your character to ignore their choices.
Moment of Truth: The hanging-in-the-balance moment when your character makes a choice.
Final State - The aftermath of that choice.
